

August 15th - October 31st | Tuesdays-Saturdays | 9AM-5PM

Leaves can only be directly collected from trees with orange ribbons and identification tags/signs. A complete tree list can be found on the reverse side of this map.

Area 1 - Main Gates Entrance: 27 marked trees along the Main Entrance off of Elks Road. Park in the Nature Center Parking Lot.



Area 2 - Native Woody Plant Preserve: 23 marked trees in the highlighted area.

Park in the East Side Parking Lot and walk through the East Tunnel OR park at the Nature Center and hike 0.5 miles to the Native Woody Plant Preserve using the paved path.

NOTICE

Trees in the Native Woody Plant Preserve (#28-50) are listed in alphabetical order NOT in the order that you will find them.

Please do not damage trees by yanking leaves or breaking branches. Remove leaves correctly by following the leaf stem to the branch and break the stem backwards. The leaf will snap off. This will also ensure that you get the entire leaf with respect to whether it is a "simple" or "compound" leaf.
