The Super Troop year begins August 1, 20__, and ends July 1, 20__.

Super Troop Criteria (must complete eight of the below)

- Participated in Early Bird or if a new troop, 80% of troop registered by October 1.
- Participate in the Fall Product Sale Program with a troop per girl sales average 25% higher than council average (2010-2011 council average is \$575 sold per participating troop – to qualify troops would sell at least \$718.75).
- Participate in the Girl Scout Cookie Sale Program with a troop per girl sales average 25% higher than council average (2010-2011 council average is 144 packages sold per girl – to qualify troops would have a per girl average of 180).
- Help increase girl or adult membership. Do one of the following:
 - Add two girls to your troop
 - Recruit a new leader
 - Recruit a new volunteer to assist in a [council event](#)
 - Help at a council led [recruitment event](#)
- Attend four service unit meetings or events
- Attend one council activity/event or troop camp at a council facility overnight
- 80% of families in your troop make a donation to the council's annual campaign
- Complete a Journey and submit a photo of your take action project with your Super Troop report
- Attend one adult learning opportunity
 - Core learning opportunity
 - Enrichment learning opportunity
- Submit Troop Annual Report to your service unit manager no later than July 1
