

Resident Camp Packing Information

In addition to the general list, campers in these programs should pack the following:
Don't forget to pack raingear! Camp goes on, even in the rain!

Aquatic Programs (A Pirate's Life For Me, Aqua Adventures, Aqua Sampler, Beach Party, Gallahue's Regatta, Horse and Goggles, Paddling Around, Summer Fun)

- ❑ 2 bathing suits
- ❑ Extra towels for beach use
- ❑ Set of clothes for water use (shirt, shorts, shoes)
- ❑ Sunscreen

Horseback Programs (Buckmasters, Hoofprints, Mini Wrangler, Ringmasters, Saddle Club, Starry Nights, Horsing Around, Trailblazers, WIT, Wranglers, Yearlings)

- ❑ Boots or shoes with a 1" heel and a smooth sole, sneakers are okay, but boots are preferred.
 - No hiking boots

3 pairs long pants/jeans, 4/5 pairs for two week sessions

Programs that have some horseback riding

(Best Day Ever, Horse and Goggles, Pony Tales, Sampler, All The Things You Can Do, Care and Keeping of Magical Creatures)

- ❑ Boots or shoes with a 1" heel and a smooth sole, sneakers are okay, but boots are preferred.
 - No hiking boots
- ❑ 1 pair long pants/jeans,

Mini-Wrangler/ Wrangler Information

Only campers registered in the Mini Wrangler and Wrangler program need to attend the testing. No girls registered in Hoofprints, yearlings, Ringmasters please!

- ❑ Mini-Wranglers, Wrangler MUST take the proficiency test at our Open House on May 19th from 2:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Tripping Units (Splendid Spelunking, Indiana Jane, Into the Woods, Summer Fun, Zipping It, Out of the Woods, Shred It, Big South Fork, Out and About)

- ❑ Backpack
- ❑ Water bottle
- ❑ Spending money (Campers will not NEED money on the trips, but are allowed to bring it if you so choose)!

Packing Tips!

- ❑ Pack clothing in zip lock/plastic bags.
- ❑ Pack those bags in a duffle bag – easier to carry than a tub!
- ❑ Pack sleeping bag/pillow/bedding in a large trash bag
- ❑ Pack extra trash bags for dirty clothing
- ❑ Pack all medication in the top of a bag so it can be easily accessed during check-in. All medication will be handed over to the Health Supervisor during check-in.
