Material List:

- Tent

- Raincoat/poncho
- Sun protection (hat, sunglasses, sunscreen, lip balm)
- First aid kit
- Pocket knife
- Medications (if necessary)
- Emergency food
- Cooler with ice or ice packs
- Prepackage snacks or food (to reduce food packaging waste)
- Towel
- Toilet paper (if necessary)
- Whistle
- Matches (in a waterproof container)
- Bug spray
- Tupperware
- Index cards (optional)
- Markers (optional)
- Surface Hopscotch directions (optional)
- Camera (encouraged to document the local wildlife)
- Trash bag
- Gloves (optional)
- Hand sanitizer/Lysol wipes
