Camp Gallahue consists of approximately 800 acres in Brown County near Morgantown, IN. The camp is located approximately 50 miles south of the GSCI Indianapolis Metro Office.

The council employs an onsite manager at Gallahue. The site manager and ranger are there to maintain the facilities and to aid groups while using them. A staff ranger, not always the on-site person, is on call at camp 24 hours/seven days a week except published holidays.

Arrival and Departure

Check in and check out times are as follows: Any change in these times needs to be requested at the time of reservation.

Check in: 4:00 pm or after

Check out: 2:00 pm or before

If troops want to check-in before the specified time, they need to pay for the day/night before as well. If troops want to check out later than the specified time, they need to pay for the next day/night as well.

Smoking: Smoking is PROHIBITED on all Girl Scout properties.

Pets: Pets are not permitted in the camp with the exception of service dogs. Please make us aware if someone has a service dog.

Alcohol and Drugs: Alcoholic beverages and drugs are strictly prohibited.

Cancellations

The full fee for use of the facility is due in the office one month before the reservation. If payment is not received in the office one month before the reserved date, the reservation will be cancelled. The funds will be transferred to another date if

- A cancellation is received three weeks prior to the event.
- Weather conditions causing travel to be hazardous or camp to close.

When it is necessary to cancel please call the council office as soon as possible so that another group might be considered. Someone is always expecting your group; please notify the office even at the last minute if you plan not to attend. You may call 317.924.6827 or 317.924.6856 at any hour and leave a message.

DESCRIPTION OF FACILITIES

FOUR TENT UNITS (ARDATH, ART COLONY, VILLAGE & RESERVATION) each unit consists of a large activity cabin with ten nearby platform tents (each platform tent contains 4 cots with mattresses) for sleeping. Sanitary facilities are pit latrines, enclosed and partitioned. Cabins have modern kitchens and substantial activity space, to be shared by troops staying in the unit, for get-togethers, cooking, etc. Equipment included in each unit area cabin: fireplace, five tables and chairs seating 8 each, gas furnace (Ardath & Art Colony only, have a gas furnace). Included in the kitchen are triple sinks with not and cold running water, electric refrigerator and freezer compartment, gas range and oven, four burners and griddle, storage cabinets, work table.

HILLCREST has 3 wings each consisting of sleeping room with cots & mattresses, private restroom and showers, table and chairs, and modern kitchen and gas furnace. *(Wing 1 has 14 beds, Wing 2 has 12 beds, Wing 3 has 14 beds) Kitchen: Electric range/oven, microwave, double sink w/ hot & cold running water, refrigerator/freezer, cabinets, small counter area. (There are 5 fire bowls near Hillcrest for troops/groups to use).

LODGE: The Gallahue Lodge contains:

- Large institutional kitchen (includes griddle)
- Seats 150 for meals
- Sleeping accommodations for 50 (mattresses provided) (LODGE BASEMENT ONLY)
- Patio overlooking the lake
- Heated for year round use
- Three fireplaces with the large one in the upstairs main room, one in basement, & one outside the basement. (There are no fire bowls located near the Lodge)
- Easy access for the handicapped
- Lodge basement includes modern kitchen includes: refrigerator/freezer, electric range/oven,
 Microwave, double bowl sink)
- Microwave (1 big one in upstairs of Lodge, 1 small/regular size in basement kitchen)
- Shower (one shower located in basement of Lodge)

ADIRONDACK UNIT (Harley's Hill) Three sided shelter for sleeping picnic style shelter (located behind Village) with tables, a pit latrine, fire bowl. NO ELECTRICITY OR WATER. Sleeps a total of 20 persons/ 4 huts each sleeping 5 persons.)

PRIMITIVE CAMPING SITES: Unlimited site capacity. Sites include fire bowls, fire grates, and picnic tables. Water is available from a pump located in the center of the valley. Sanitary facilities are pit latrines, enclosed and partitioned. They are located at each end of the valley.

SHOWERS: A central camp shower (all showers are individual) with hot and cold running water is available for your use April 1 through November 1. The shower house is located near the Lodge. Porta potties are also located near the Beach Area.

PICNIC AREA – Available for day use. Sanitary facilities are pit latrines, enclosed and partitioned. They are located at each end of the valley.

ACTIVITIES ON SITE

WATERFRONT: Open April 1 thru October 31 (excluding mid-late may thru early August). The waterfront is available for use on Saturdays from 10:00 a.m.-12:30 p.m. and/or 1:00-3:30 p.m. Troops must reserve the Waterfront through the council prior to date of use for one of these time periods. The council provides trained waterfront staff for swimming and certified small craft safety personnel supervision for boating activities. These activities can include canoeing, kayaking, row boating, and use of the pontoon boat. All swimming and boating takes place in designated areas only.

ARCHERY: (Girls must be age 9 and above to use archery equipment). Open April 1 thru October 31 (excluding mid-late May thru early August). An archery range with equipment is available for troops and groups to reserve prior to date of use. Please note: Troops/Groups must supply their own Certified Archery Instructor in order to use the range & equipment.

AMPHITHEATER: Troops and service units may reserve this outdoor arena for large group productions, campfires, meetings and recognition events. (The amphitheater has electricity and has seating for up to 200 persons). A sound system is available for use at the Amphitheater, however, request for use of the sound system, must be made prior to use so rangers can set up.

HIKING TRAILS: The Hills of Gallahue Trail is approximately 7½ hilly miles. A patch is available to all hikers who complete the trail and may be purchased at the Girl Scout Service Center Showcase Store.

TETHERBALL is offered in each unit area at Gallahue.

Housekeeping

The rangers do not perform cleaning services. It is the responsibility of everyone using the camp property to leave it in better condition than they found it. The facilities ultimately belong to each Girl Scout and will reflect the care she gives them.

- □ Please condense and place all other trash/garbage in lined containers provided at each site. Please make sure each container is secure to discourage wildlife.
- Please replace all trash can liners.
- □ Please do not burn trash.

Each group must provide their own eating utensils. It is important that all paper products be removed from the latrines, tents, and units at the end of your stay. Brooms, mops, rakes, and shovels are available in each unit.


Drive East on 3rd Street .7 miles to S. Smith Road. Turn <u>left</u> onto S. Smith Road and continue .6 miles to 10th Street (also called State Road 45). Turn <u>right</u> onto 10th St./SR 45 and continue East for 13.1 miles (You will pass Unionville Elementary School about 6.4 miles along SR 45. In 6.7 more miles--at 13.1 miles total, you will see "Self's Bait and Supply" shop on your right.)

Take your next possible <u>left</u> onto Bear Creek Road. .4 miles to stop sign. Turn <u>left</u> at the stop sign onto North Bear Creek Road. (It has no street sign, but will be a 4 way intersection with Richards--which is what Bear Creek becomes if you mistakenly go straight ahead onto the gravel). Continue 1.7 miles on North Bear Creek Road to Dudley Gallahue Valley Camp on your left. Turn <u>left</u> into Gallahue Valley Camp, and drive up the gravel drive .7 miles.



DIRECTIONS TO GALLAHUE VALLEY CAMPS


Follow state road 135 south from Indianapolis to Beanblossom. At Beanblossom turn west (right) on state road 45. Continue on 45 to 3 way stop at railroad tracks. Turn left to continue on 45 through Helmsburg. Two miles after Helmsburg General Store, turn right at Gallahue sign onto Branstetter Road; at stop sign continue straight on Bear Creek Road and continue until reaching sign on your left indicating Gallahue entrance. OR Continue on 45 past fire station and cross railroad tracks to Trevlac. Turn right over railroad tracks and continue to the right on road to stop sign. Turn left onto Bear Creek Road and continue until reaching sign on your left indicating Gallahue Valley Girl Scout Camp entrance. (Directions Note: For persons who aren't familiar with State Road 135, it is the same as south Meridian Street on Indianapolis' south side). However, there is not an exit off I-465 to south Meridian Street. You will need take the U.S. 31 South exit off I-465 and go south to the first stoplight (Thompson Road). Turn right (west) on Thompson Road and continue to the next stoplight (intersection of Thompson Road and south Meridian Street), turn left (south) at the light and follow directions above).




